Information for the Just Lorem Ipsum Scribus templates

The Software

If you are using Linux, the following programs may be avail-able through your repository. If you are using Mac or Windows, go to the respective downloads page and follow the directions. I used Scribus to make the book interior, Inkscape to make the cover, and the GIMP to convert raster graphics file from one format to another. I use LibreOffice for general word processing, spreadsheet, and presentation functions. LibreOffice is a office suite. It is an open-source alternative to Micro-soft Office. Scribus is a desktop publishing program, an open-source alternative to Adobe InDesign. The GIMP is an alternative to Adobe Photoshop and Inkscape is an alternative to Adobe Illustrator. Disclaimer: I use Adobe InDesign to design book interiors for myself and others. I haven't used Adobe Photoshop or Adobe Illustrator since I left the Mac world for Linux about in about 1999. I am occasionally forced to use Microsoft products in my day job, but I try to avoid that whenever possible.

The Fonts

The fonts used in Just Lorem Ipsum are all free. I made extensive use of Latin Modern Roman (LM Roman): Most of the front matter, the body text, and the running heads are LM Roman. I used regular, small caps, and italic in various sizes. Cinzel is a typeface inspired by 1st century Roman inscriptions. I used it for the chapter numbers and the table of contents. I used Fira Sans Condensed for the chapter titles and for the headings in the appendix.

Format

I wanted a different format from the 6x9 format that I used for my other Scribus templates. 5.25x8 seemed like a good size for a short book.

- Text frame size: 3.8125 in. x 6.6833 in.
- Body font: Latin Modern Roman 12 Regular, 10 point
- Leading: 14 pt
- Lines per page: 34
- Words per line: 9.1
- Words per page: 308
- Characters per line: 61.4

Styles

Everything in Just Lorem Ipsum is assigned a style with the exception of the italics of book names in the appendix, which are applied in the story editor. The individual elements in the front matter are arranged in text frames and assigned their individual style. This way you can change the font or size of each element individually to customize your book. Here are the assigned styles.

- Chapter Number: Cinzel Regular, 18 pt, left
- Default Paragraph Style (can't delete this): LM Roman 10 regular, 10 pt, justified
- Finis: Fira Sans Condensed, 32 pt, centered
- Front Contents: Cinzel Bold, 14 pt, centered
- Front Contents Chapters: Cinzel Regular, 12 pt, 18 pt lead, centered
- Front Copyright: LM Roman 10 Regular, 12 pt, centered
- Front Dedication: LM Roman Caps 10 Regular, 12 pt, automatic linespacing, centered
- Front Main Author: LM Roman 10 Regular, 16 pt, centered

- Paragraph No Indent: LM Roman 12 Regular, 10 pt, 14 pt lead, justified
- Praise Book Title: LM Roman 12 Bold, 14 pt, centered
- Praise Justified Left: LM Roman 12 Regular, 12 pt, 15 pt lead, justified
- Praise Justified Right: LM Roman 12 Regular, 12 pt, 15 lead, right
- Praise Praise for: LM Roman 12 Italic, 14 pt, centered
